## ATTESTATION FOR PRE-GRADUATION RN APPLICANT DISASTER PERMIT

### PART I – Student Applicant Information

**Applicant Instructions:** By submitting this form you are requesting to provide services in Louisiana during a disaster as an RN Applicant prior to completion of and/or prior to graduation from your nursing education program. To be eligible for a Pre-Graduation RN Applicant Disaster Permit you must have submitted an application as a new graduate for licensure by examination, submit a verification from your nursing program (below), have no grounds for disciplinary action with LSBN, and be in good standing and enrolled in the last semester of a nursing education program approved by the board. In order to request a Pre-Graduation RN Applicant Disaster Permit, fill out the **top** portion of this form and forward to the educational institution you are attending. After the faculty completes Part II, submit/upload this completed form in the message center of the nurse portal using the category **RN Licensure by Exam**.

By signing below, you attest that you are the party referred to in this document; that the information provided is true in every respect; that you will comply with and otherwise abide by all applicable laws, rules, and regulations, including but not limited to those relating to RN practice as specified in accord with LAC Title 46, Part XLVII, Subpart 2; and that you further comply with and attest to acknowledging and understanding the following:

- the permit authorizes practice as an RN Applicant only in nursing situations where direct RN supervision is available;
- the permit authorizes limited practice in a staff nurse position in the state of Louisiana;
- the permit shall be valid for 120 days and may be extended as determined by the board;
- after issuance of the permit, use the title “preRN app” after signatures on records;
- issuance of the permit does not negate licensure requirements following the public health emergency;
- issuance of the permit is verifiable through LSBN’s online licensure verification service: <https://lsbn.boardsfnursing.org/licenselookup>;
- after LSBN staff have confirmed you have graduated, the disaster permit will be converted to a graduate permit.
