RE: Nursing Practice Opinion

Dear Ms. Pomeroy:

Your request for an opinion of the Board of Nursing regarding a registered nurse delegating clean intermittent catheterizations to health assistants in group homes was presented to the Board at its meeting on July 19, 1990.

The Nursing Practice Committee had reviewed all of the information you sent and had studied the issue. The members of the Committee appreciated your availability for a conference at the meeting to further clarify your situation. At the July 19 meeting, the Committee presented its recommendations to the Board. After due deliberation, the Board adopted the following opinion:

In reference to Agenda Item # 13, a registered nurse may delegate clean intermittent catheterizations to unlicensed personnel in small group homes, provided the delegatee has had a minimum of eight (8) hours of classroom training and supervised practice, consistent with the 1990 House Bill 886 of Louisiana.
