Dear Mesdames Jeansonne and Lanza:

Your request for an opinion of the Board of Nursing regarding a registered nurse delegating to an unlicensed person simple wound care, such as a wound that would require cleansing, application of a nonprescription gel or ointment, eg. Carrington gel, and application of a dressing was presented to the Board at its August 24, 1995 meeting.

The Nursing Practice Committee studied your request and reviewed previous related opinions of the Board. The Committee then formulated a recommendation to the Board of Nursing. On August 24, 1995 the Committee presented its recommendation to the Board, and after due deliberation, the Board adopted the following opinion:

In reference to agenda item 5.3, it is not in accordance with the administrative rules on delegation of nursing functions for the registered nurse to delegate simple wound care to unlicensed personnel.
