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## Staff Vacancies

### Recovering Nurse Program Manager

The Louisiana State Board of Nursing invites applicants for the position of Recovering Nurse Program Manager. This is an administrative position responsible for the activities of the Board which relate to the intake of participants into the Recovering Nurse Program (RNP) including but not necessarily limited to:

- Working with nursing employers to determine if cause exists to recommend a nurse to the RNP.
- Explaining the RNP to appropriate nurses
- Facilitating entry into treatment
- Receiving and reviewing records from the treatment center.
- Facilitating the return to work of participants
- Managing a large case load of participants.
- Limited availability for facilitating interventions.
- The Program Manager is responsible to the Executive Director of the Board through the Director of Monitoring and is at the Civil Service grade level of MS 521. Salary range for this position is \$49,528-\$98,804. Salary negotiable within the civil service range and includes compensation for education and experience, retirement benefits may be transferred.

- Varied experience in nursing, including, but not limited to at least five (5) years of successful experience in clinical nursing practice and recent experience in substance abuse/addiction recovery treatment and/or psychiatric/mental health nursing;

- Broad concept of nursing practice and the ability to interpret the role of nursing in society effectively;
- Personal and professional integrity;
- Objectivity;
- Knowledge of the functions of state government;
- Skill in verbal, written and listening communication;
- Good interpersonal skills
- Ability to travel;
- Commitment to the purpose and mission of the Board of Nursing;
- Ability to operate office equipment. Must have computer skills and be able to access and accomplish on-line processing through mainframe and networked systems, world-wide web, and central data systems and ability to identify problems for users and make recommendations for resolutions of problems in operation of same;

## Major Motions of the October 20-21, 2008 Board Meeting

### Education Issues

**Accepted** the site visit report and grant full approval status of Our Lady of the Lake College Nurse Anesthesia Program and commend the 100% pass rate on the CRNA exam of their first class.

**Approved** the request by the University of Arkansas for the Medical Sciences College of Nursing to conduct clinical experiences at Christus Schumpert Health System in Shreveport.

**Approve** the recommendation to terminate the Associate of Science Nursing Program at Nicholls State University in accordance with LAC46:XLVII.3531.A.

### Practice Issues

**Approved** for rule-making the final “peripherally inserted central catheter (PICC) insertion,” including verification of catheter tip placement. (Please see website for updates)

In response to an opinion request related to the scope of practice for a RN to remove peripheral nerve block catheters (interscalene/femoral/sciatic/lumbar plexus), the Board **ruled** that it is within the scope of practice for a RN to remove peripheral nerve block catheters (interscalene/femoral/sciatic/lumbar plexus).

In response to an opinion request related to scope of practice for a RN to administer care for patients with an ON-Q

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## Major Motions of the October 20-21, 2008 Board Meeting

### Practice Issues (Cont...)

C-BLOC, including the following: Removal of the catheter, increasing and decreasing rate of infusion in accordance with physician's order, and restarting infusion once stopped, the Board **directed** staff to schedule meetings between persons of interest to discuss statutory changes regarding the administration of anesthesia agents in postoperative continuous nerve blockage systems.

### Administrative Issues

**Accepted** the Administrative Committee's recommendation to purchase an electronic fingerprinting system.

**Approved** the Board staff to establish a Nursing Center and adopt the proposed By-Law provisions to do so and directed the Executive Director to develop an Action Plan using whatever resources are appropriate for these purposes.

**Approved** the request to amend the 2008-2009 Budget to incorporate changes necessary to implement the proposal for the Nursing Center and provide appropriate personnel, as directed in SR 152.

**Accepted** the job description for the director of the Nursing Center as an unclassified position until such time as a position can be created for that position to meet the requirements of SR 152.

**Accepted** the proposal to co-sponsor the Louisiana Nursing Summit.

### Compliance Issues

**Approved** to initiate rulemaking for the revision of an addition to LAC46:XLVII.333.B Renewal of License as follows:

§3333. Renewal of License

B. Requirements for renewal of license include:

Provide any/all information, documents, records, reports, evidence and/or items as requested by the board/Board staff within 60 days from the date of the letter of request/notification sent by Board staff, or else the RN license shall be subject to immediate invalidation by Board staff with change of status to inactive license and practice as a Registered Nurse will no longer be legal.

### Compliance Issues (Cont...)

**Approved** to initiate rulemaking for the revision of an addition to LAC46:XLVII.3405. Definitions of Terms as follows:

§3405. Definition of Terms, Other Causes

S. Failure to cooperate with the Board by:

- i. not furnishing in writing a full and complete explanation covering a matter requested by the Board; or
- ii. not providing information, documents/record, reports, evidence or any other requested items within the designated time period to the board office as requested by the Board/Board staff.
- iii. not respond to subpoenas issued by the Board in connection with any investigation or hearing.
- iv. not completing evaluations required by the Board.

**Approved** to initiate rulemaking for the revision of an addition to LAC46:XLVII.3419 Alternative to Disciplinary Proceedings as follows:

§3419 Alternative to Disciplinary Proceedings

H. Discretionary Authority

3. The board may cause to be made non-confidential the records, files, and information related to successful completion of an RNP program in the event that a former participant subsequently violates the Nurse Practice Act or the rules of the Board.

The responsibility rests with the licensee to assure that the Board has a current address on file at all times. Failure to properly notify the Board of one's current address can result in a lapsed license, noncompliance with regulations of the Board, or disciplinary action in the nurse's absence. **Correspondence to the last known address is legal notice.**
