2011 Online Licensure Renewals

Online Licensure Renewal starts October 1, 2010 at noon. Online renewal of licensure is mandatory. To renew online, visit <http://www.lsbm.state.la.us> and select **Online License Renewal** to begin the process.

The Louisiana State Board of Nursing sends out several 'renewal reminder' messages to all actively licensed RNs and APRNs during the active renewal season to the email address on file with the Board. Please make sure you have a current email address on file with LSBN so that you can receive these and other notices promptly.

If you should have a change of your email address, postal mailing address or contact phone number (s), please go online to your LSBN account under **Services** and update this information under either **My Profile** (for phone number and email updates) and **Address Change** (for updates of your postal mail address) within 30 days of the change or prior to renewing.

You can confirm the information has been updated by waiting 20-30 minutes (the processing time for our computer system) and going back into the same area you posted the change.

The LSBN computer system is able to accommodate **one (1) home mailing address** and **one (1) email address per nurse**.

Please remember Louisiana RN and APRN nursing licenses are 'calendar' year licenses. Applications submitted after December 31 will be considered late and subject to a late fee. If you have completed your re-licensure requirements for the year, we encourage you to renew when the online system is activated in early October and prior to December 31st.

Out of State Nursing Program

In accordance with **Louisiana Revised Statutes 17:1808**, an out-of-state institution of higher learning may not offer courses in Louisiana unless registered with the Louisiana Board of Regents. This includes students in clinical nursing courses or preceptorship courses at undergraduate and graduate levels. Further, the Louisiana State Board of nursing has standards for the clinical practice of students and must approve the nursing program, the clinical practice sites and the students prior to their engaging in clinical practice in Louisiana.

NCSBN Recruiting Registered Nurses

The National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) is recruiting registered nurses (RNs) for two upcoming meetings. The meetings are: RN Practice Analysis Expert Panel Meeting to be held November 8-10, 2010 and the RN KSA Expert Panel Meeting to be held December 1-3, 2010. Both meetings will take place in Chicago.

NCSBN conducts an RN Practice Analysis and an RN KSA meeting every three years in order to ensure that the NCLEX-RN® exam continues to reflect current nursing practice.

Registered Nurse – active nursing license in good standing
Current clinical practice
Works with and/or supervises newly licensed RNs within their first 12 months of practice

Louisiana Center for Nursing Update

The Louisiana Center for Nursing (LCN), which is a division of the Louisiana State Board of Nursing (LSBN), has been charged with collecting, analyzing and reporting registered nurse workforce data utilizing established nursing supply, demand, and predictor models to forecast registered nurse resource needs for Louisiana. As a member of the Forum for State Nursing Workforce Centers (<http://www.nursingworkforcecenters.org>), LCN has adopted the Forum's minimum datasets for collecting nursing supply, nursing education capacity, and nursing demand data. For many years LSBN has collected data relative to nursing supply through the registered nurse annual licensure renewal process. Nursing education capacity data is obtained from annual reports submitted to LSBN by Pre-RN licensure programs and Master's programs offering advanced practice registered nursing degrees. Data related to registered nurse demand, which in economic terms, refers to an organization's willingness to purchase (pay wages for) the healthcare services provided by registered nurses (RNs) is an essential component used in forecasting models to predict future nursing workforce needs, yet nursing demand data has historically been the most challenging type of data to collect (Buerhaus, Staiger and Auerbach, 2009).

In August 2010, the Louisiana Center for Nursing, in collaboration with the Nursing Supply and Demand Council will begin a first-time project to collect nursing demand data for RNs, licensed practical nurses (LPNs) and certified nursing assistants (CNAs) in Louisiana. Major employers of RNs, LPNs and CNAs will be surveyed and will be asked to respond to questions such as: *What is the number of full-time and part-time RNs currently employed? What is the current number of vacant RN positions in your facility? How many new nursing positions will the organization intend to create over the next one to two years?* The information gained with these surveys will be used to develop a report on the current and future nursing workforce demand in the state of Louisiana.

In light of the passage of the Patient Protection and Affordability Care Act (PPACA), there could potentially be an additional 32 million Americans that will be eligible for healthcare coverage in the U.S. It is imperative that Louisiana be proactive in making sure that an adequate nursing workforce be available to provide safe, effective nursing care to its constituents. 

Every RN with a Louisiana license is responsible for immediately notifying the Board office in writing of any name or address change. Correspondence from the Board, such as licensure renewal, notice of Board Actions printed in The Examiner which may affect the license, as well as disciplinary charges and notice of hearing are mailed to the last known address of the Registered Nurse. The responsibility rests with the licensee to assure that the Board has a current address on file at all times. Failure to properly notify the Board of one's current address can result in a lapsed license, noncompliance with regulations of the Board, or disciplinary action in the nurse's absence. **Correspondence to the last known address is legal notice.**
