**Virtual Meeting Notice and Certification**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, pursuant to LSA-R.S. 42:19(A), that the Louisiana State Board of Nursing (the "Board"), within the Louisiana Department of Health, State of Louisiana, shall convene a regularly scheduled board panel disciplinary hearing on Wednesday, November 10, 2021, 9:00 a.m. until completed, at the offices of the Board, 17373 Perkins Road, Baton Rouge, Louisiana with the Board participating via live video streaming due the declared Covid-19 Public Health Emergency most recently renewed on October 26, 2021 in emergency proclamation 204 JBE 2021.

In accordance with LSA-R.S. 42:17.1 this notice shall serve as certification of the Louisiana State Board of Nursing's intention to hold a virtual meeting. Public participation is available via live streaming video using Microsoft Teams. Public participation is not available during executive session per LSA-R.S. 42:17. The meeting link is below.

The Louisiana State Board of Nursing will provide for attendance at its essential government meeting on November 10, 2021, via virtually via Microsoft Teams. It is essential that the Louisiana State Board of Nursing continue to operate to address:

- a) Matters that are directly related to the public body's response to the disaster or emergency and are critical to the health, safety, or welfare of the public, and/or
- b) Matters that if they are delayed will cause curtailment of vital public services or severe economic dislocation and hardship, and/or
- c) Matters that are critical to continuation of the business of the public body and that are not able to be postponed to a meeting held in accordance with the other provisions of this Chapter due to a legal requirement or other deadline that cannot be postponed or delayed by the public body, and/or
- d) Other matters that are critical or time-sensitive and that in the determination of the presiding officer should not be delayed; however, such matters shall not be considered at the meeting unless the members of the body present at the meeting approve the consideration of the matters by a two-thirds vote.

Note: Regular Meeting held and noticed pursuant to La. Rev. Stat. §42:17(A)(1), (2), (4), (5) and (10). Further, agenda items may be taken out of order and/or in executive session pursuant to R.S 42:17(A). La. R.S. 42:17(A) states "A public body may hold an executive session pursuant to R.S. 42:16 for one or more of the following reasons: (1) Discussion of the character, professional competence, or physical or mental health of a person, provided that such person is notified in writing at least twenty-four hours, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, before the scheduled time contained in the notice of the meeting at which such executive session is to take place and that such person may require that such discussion be held at an open meeting.....In cases of extraordinary emergency, written notice to such person shall not be required; however, the public body shall give such notice as it deems appropriate and circumstances permit; (2) Strategy sessions or negotiations with respect to collective bargaining, prospective litigation after formal written demand, or litigation when an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the bargaining or litigating position of the public body;....(4) Investigative proceedings regarding allegations of misconduct; (5) Cases of extraordinary emergency, which shall be limited to natural disaster, threat of epidemic, civil disturbances, suppression of insurrections, the repelling of invasions, or other matters of similar magnitude; and,....(10) Or any other matters now provided for or as may be provided for by the legislature."
