Due to COVID-19, public viewing space is limited and will be available on a first-come basis. Additionally, public participation is available via live streaming video using Microsoft Teams pursuant to LSA-R.S. 42:17.1. **Public participation is not available during executive session per LSA-R.S. 42:17.**

The State of Louisiana continues to operate under a state of public health emergency declared by the governor, as most recently renewed in Proclamations 158 JBE 2020 and 159 JBE 2020. Further, agenda items may be taken out of order and/or in executive session pursuant to R.S. 42:17A. La. R.S. 42:17(A) states "A public body may hold an executive session pursuant to R.S. 42:16 for one or more of the following reasons: (1) Discussion of the character, professional competence, or physical or mental health of a person, provided that such person is notified in writing at least twenty-four hours, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, before the scheduled time contained in the notice of the meeting at which such executive session is to take place and that such person may require that such discussion be held at an open meeting.....In cases of extraordinary emergency, written notice to such person shall not be required; however, the public body shall give such notice as it deems appropriate and circumstances permit; (2) Strategy sessions or negotiations with respect to collective bargaining, prospective litigation after formal written demand, or litigation when an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the bargaining or litigating position of the public body;....(4) Investigative proceedings regarding allegations of misconduct; (5) Cases of extraordinary emergency, which shall be limited to natural disaster, threat of epidemic, civil disturbances, suppression of insurrections, the repelling of invasions, or other matters of similar magnitude; and.....(10) Or any other matters now provided for or as may be provided for by the legislature."
