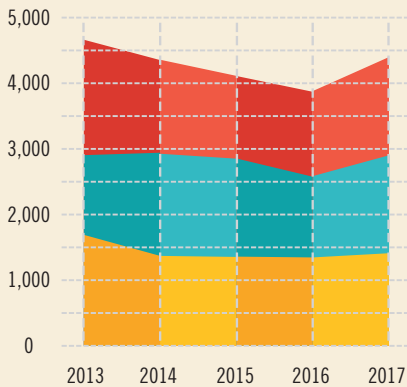

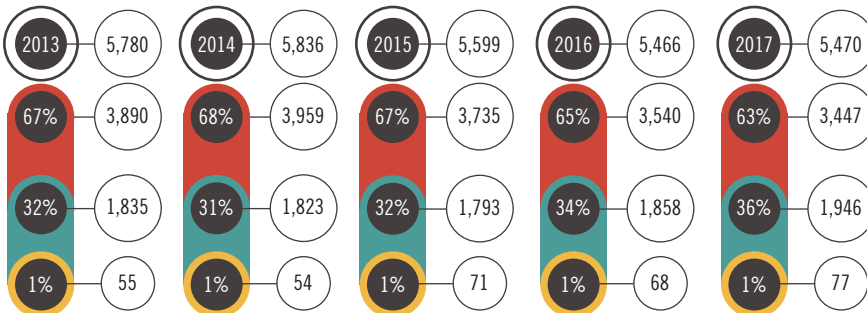

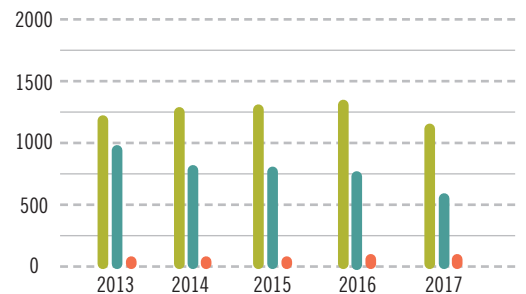

PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS ENROLLMENT IN LA (2013-2017)



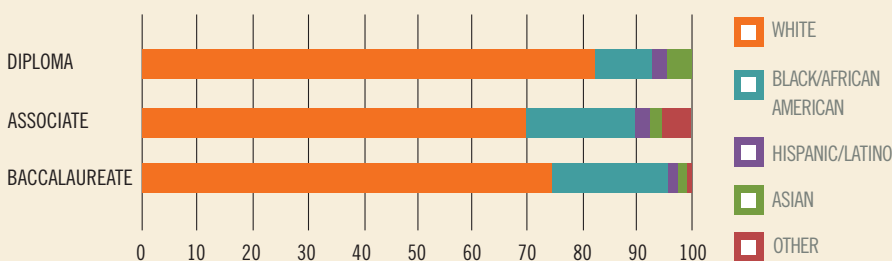

GRADUATES OF PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS IN LA ACCORDING TO PROGRAM TYPE (2013-2017)

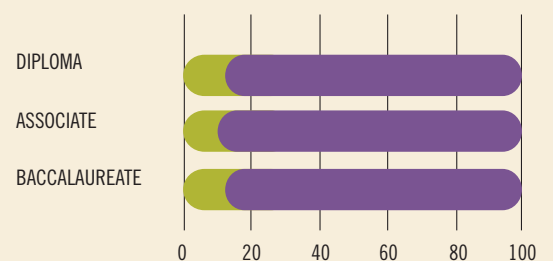

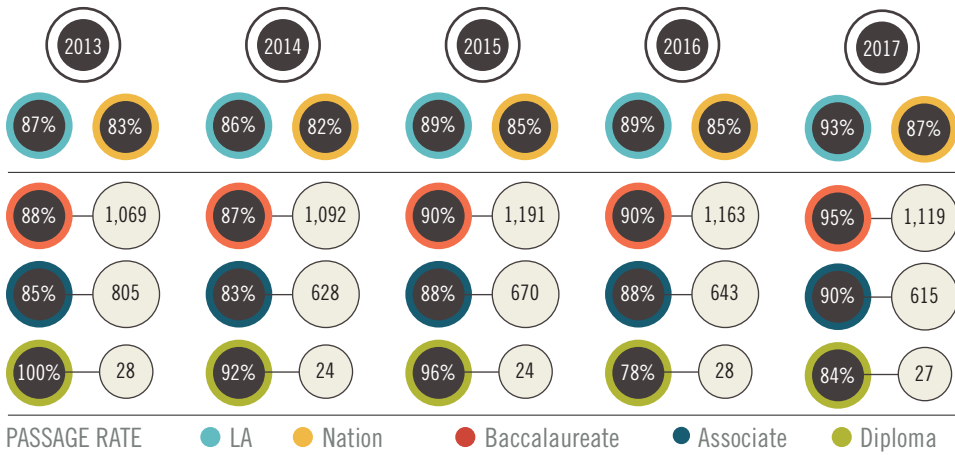
RACIAL DISTRIBUTION OF GRADUATES FROM PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS IN LA

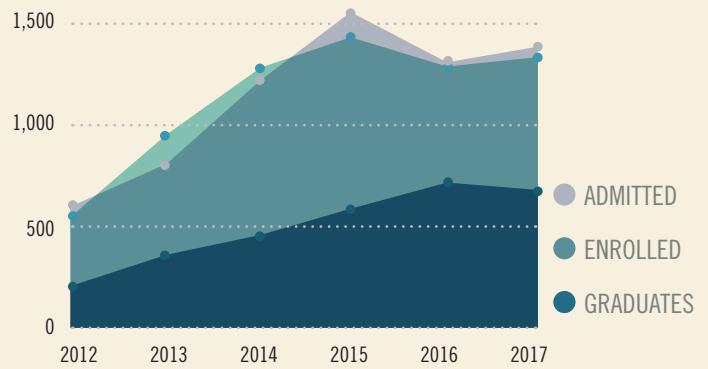
The passage rate on the NCLEX-RN for graduates from Louisiana's pre-RN licensure programs continues to exceed that of the nation.

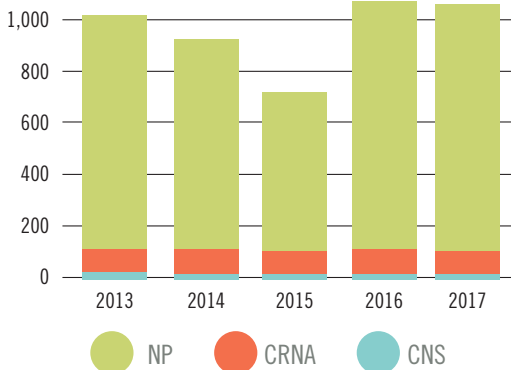

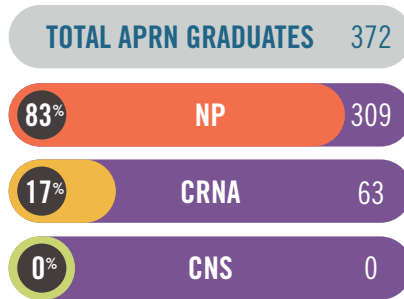

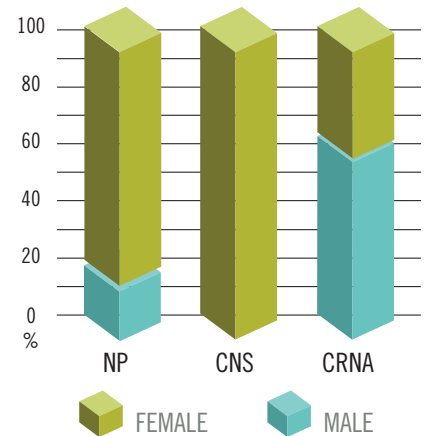
ENROLLMENT IN APRN PROGRAMS IN LA ACCORDING TO ROLE (2013-2017)



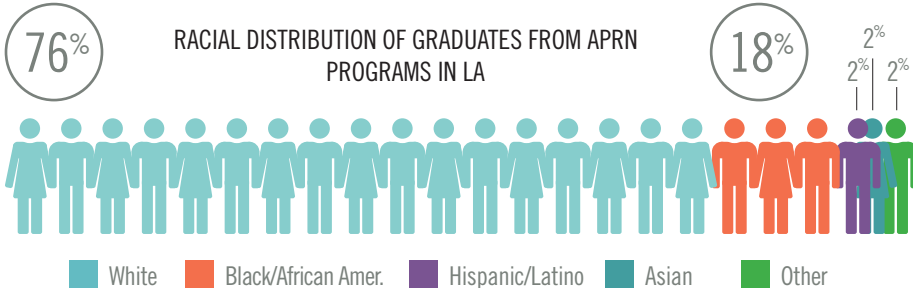
GRADUATES FROM APRN PROGRAMS IN LOUISIANA ACCORDING TO PROGRAM TYPE 2017

RACIAL DISTRIBUTION OF GRADUATES FROM APRN PROGRAMS IN LA

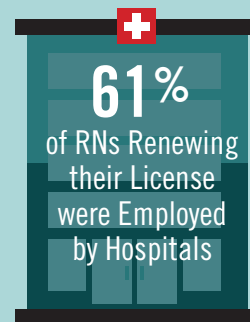

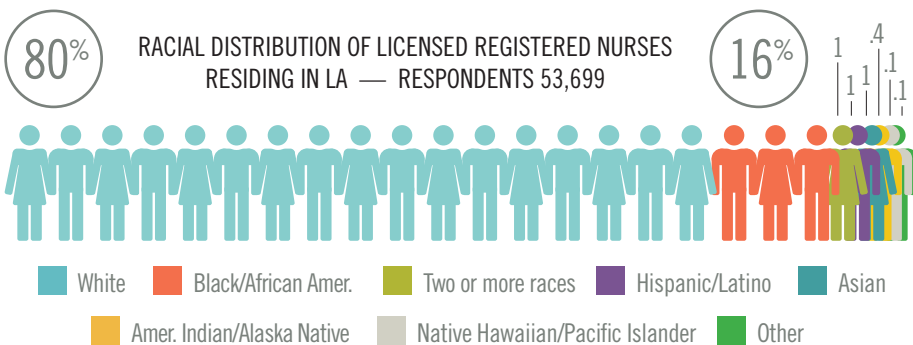

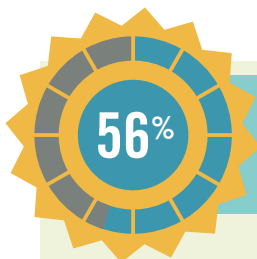
GENDER DISTRIBUTION OF LICENSED REGISTERED NURSES RESIDING IN LA

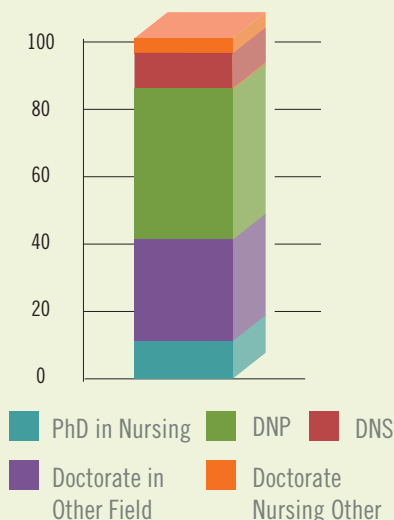

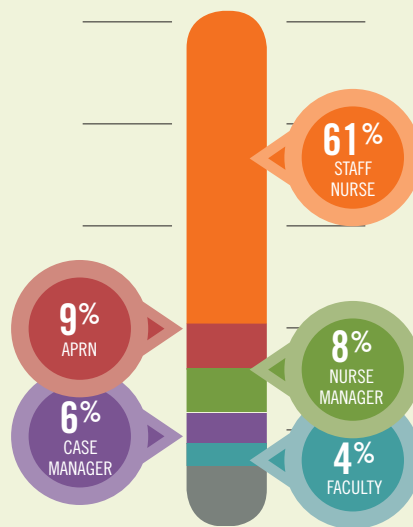

TYPES OF DOCTORATES HELD BY LICENSED RNs RENEWING THEIR LA RN LICENSE



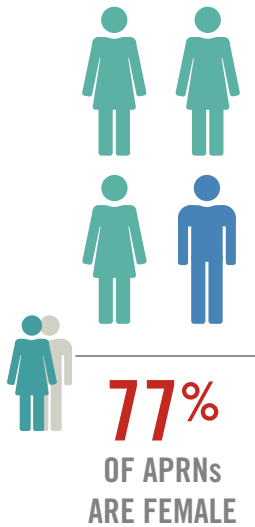
TOP 5 POSITIONS HELD BY RNS RENEWING THEIR LICENSE



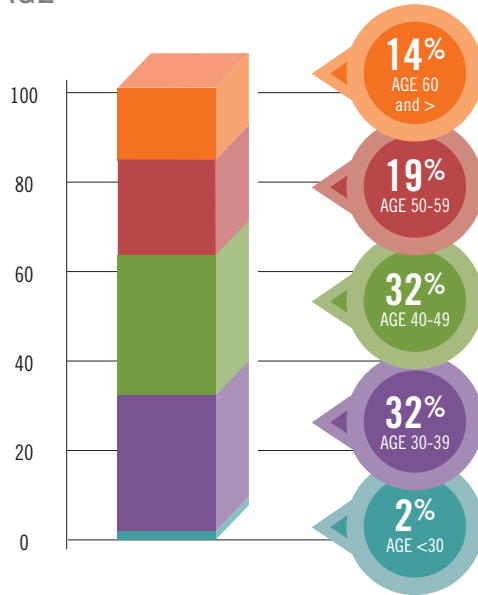

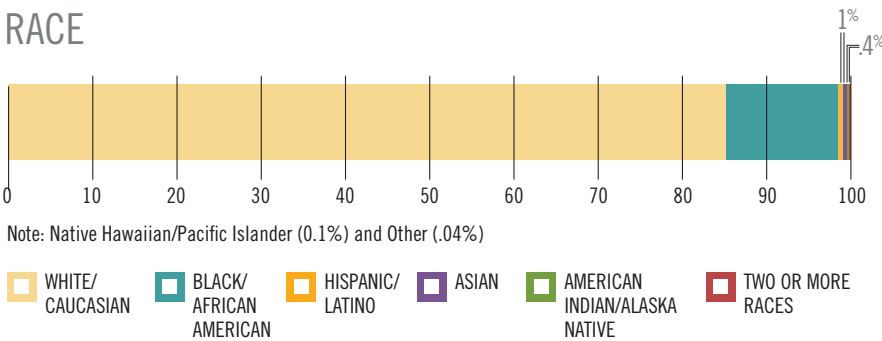

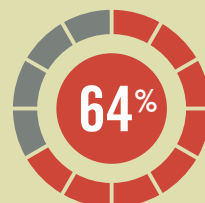
