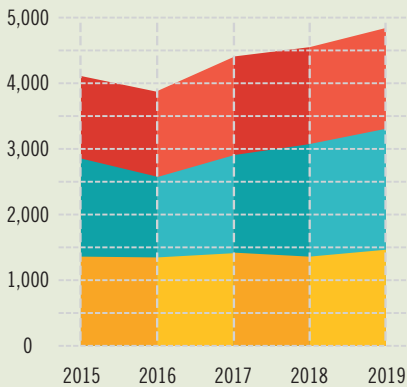

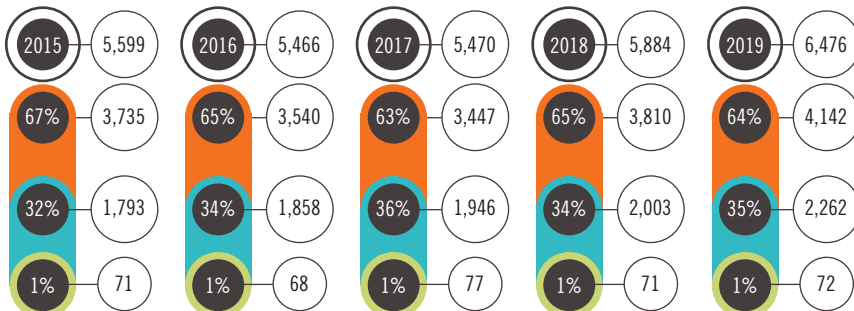

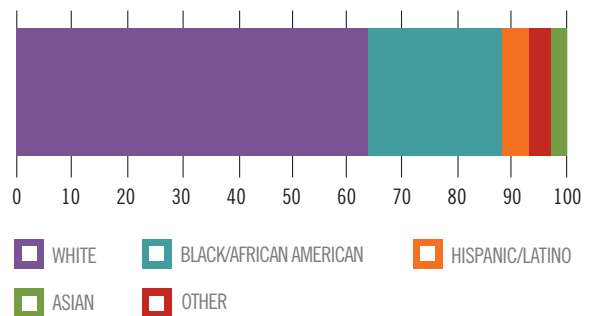

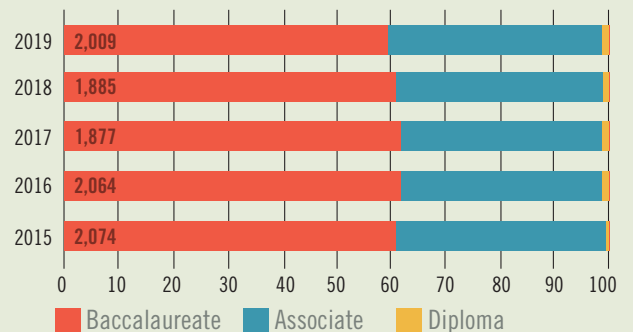
RACIAL DISTRIBUTION OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS IN LA



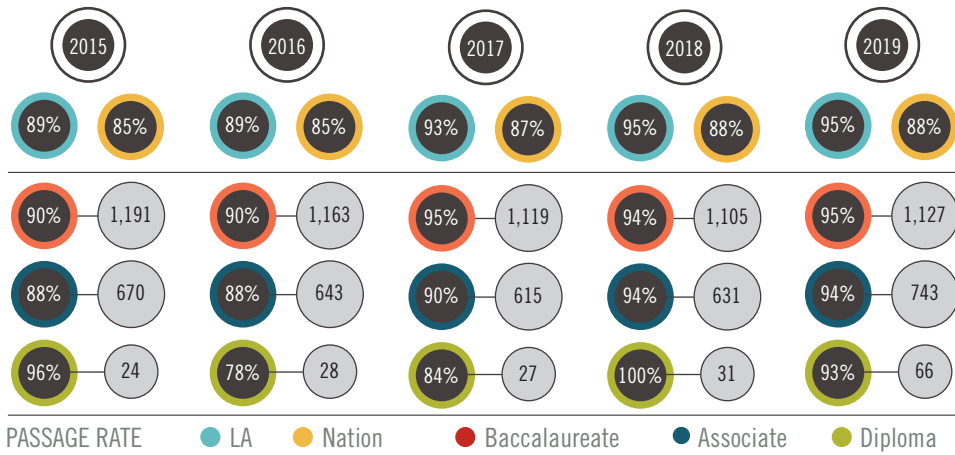
GENDER OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS IN LA



GRADUATES OF PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS IN LA ACCORDING TO PROGRAM TYPE (2015-2019)



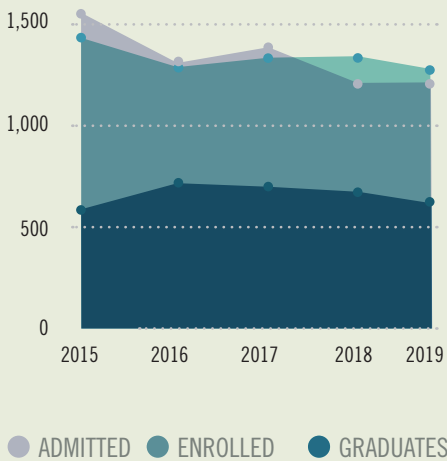

The passage rate on the NCLEX-RN for graduates from Louisiana's pre-RN licensure programs continues to exceed that of the nation.

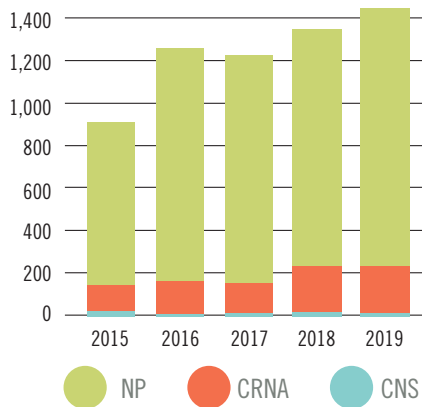

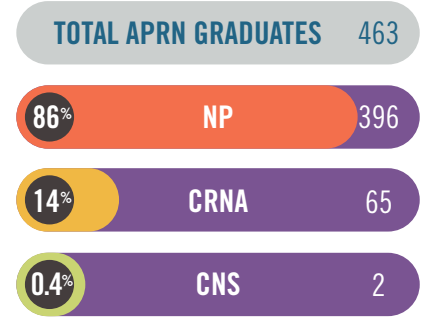


APRN EDUCATION CAPACITY

ENROLLMENT IN APRN PROGRAMS IN LA ACCORDING TO ROLE (2015-2019)

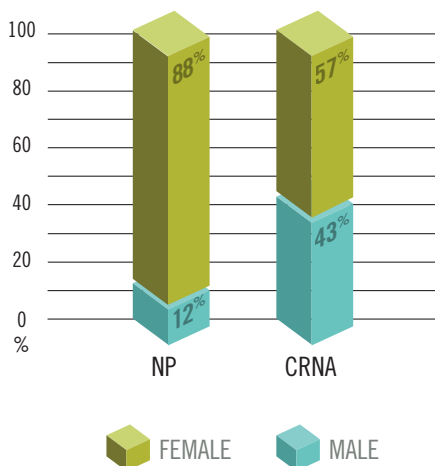


GRADUATES FROM APRN PROGRAMS IN LOUISIANA ACCORDING TO PROGRAM TYPE 2019

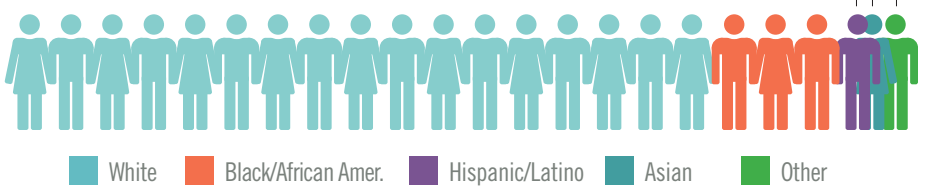

PERFORMANCE OF APRN GRADUATES ON CERTIFICATION EXAMS

In 2019 three hundred and fifty-nine (359) candidates successfully passed their certification exams resulting in a 95.23% passage rate for the state.



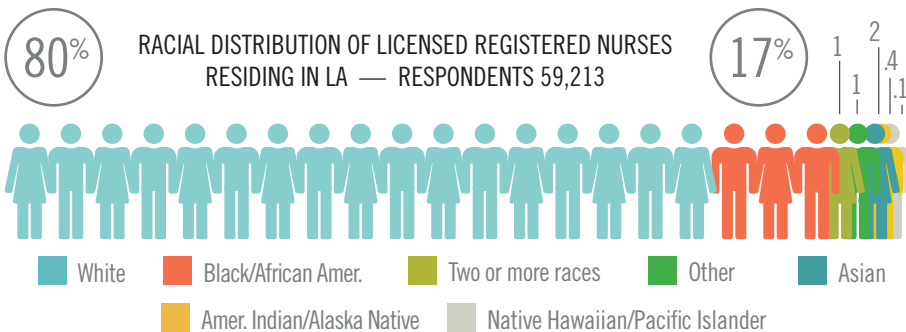

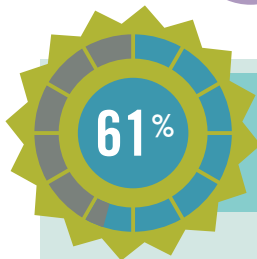

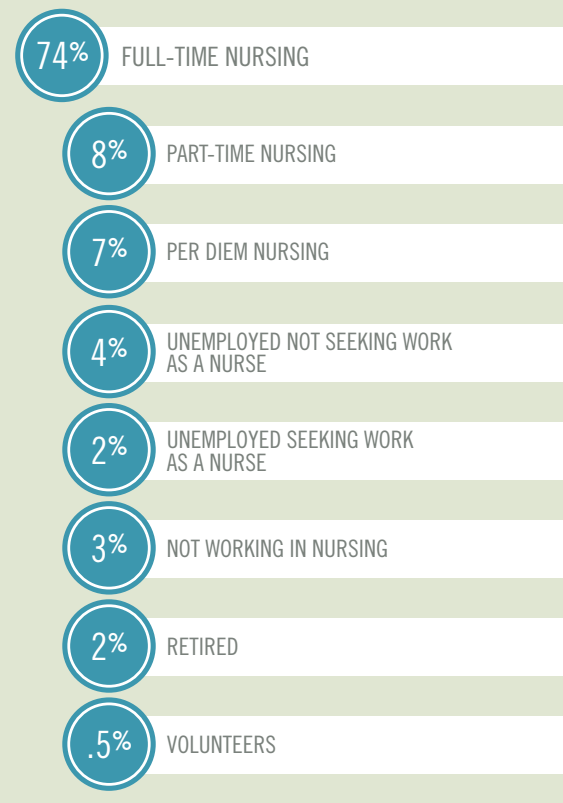

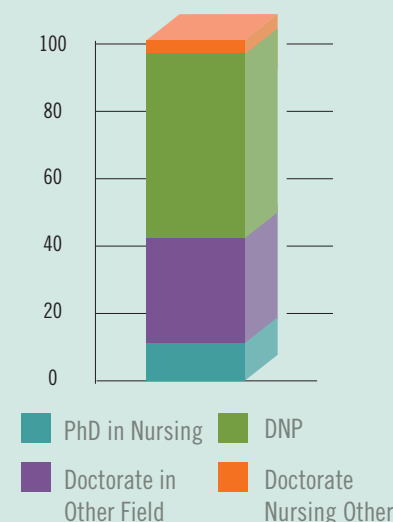

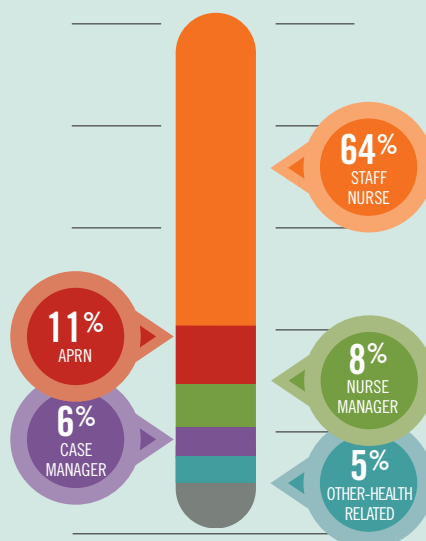
EMPLOYMENT DISTRIBUTION OF LICENSED RNs RESIDING IN LA

TOP 5 POSITIONS HELD BY LICENSED RNs RESIDING IN LA

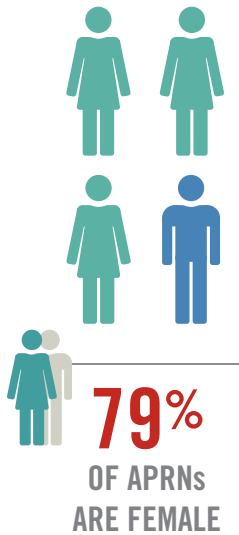

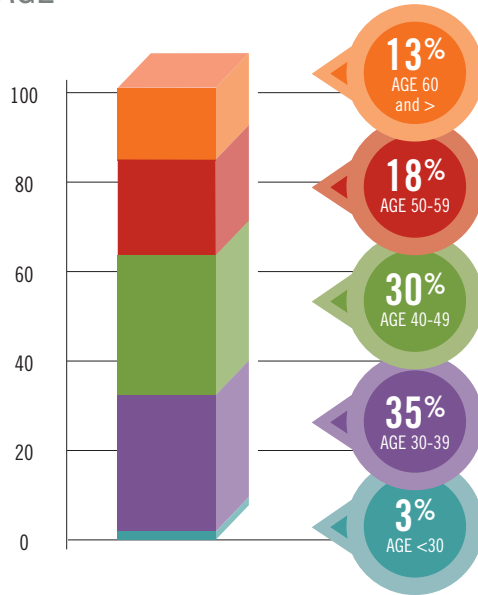

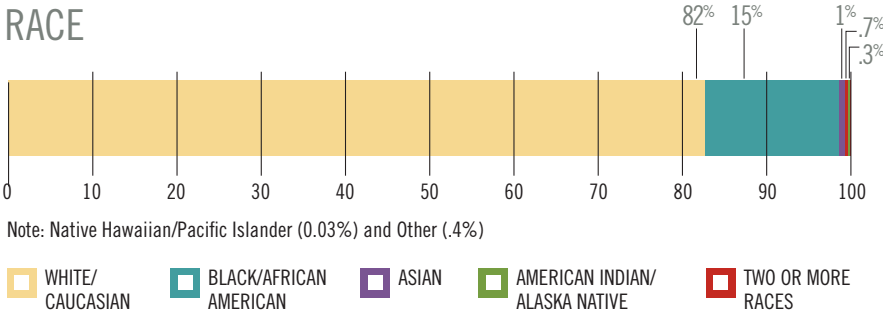

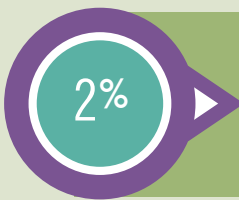

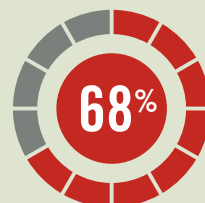
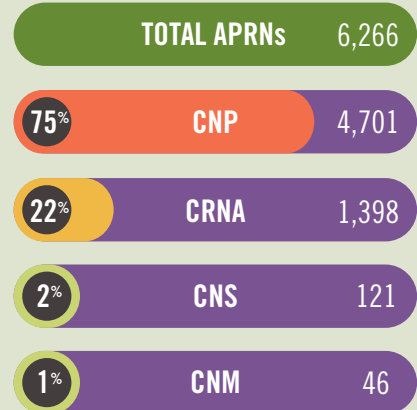
