














The passage rate on the NCLEX-RN for graduates from Louisiana's pre-RN licensure programs continues to exceed that of the nation.







# PERFORMANCE OF APRN GRADUATES ON CERTIFICATION EXAMS

In 2022 three hundred and forty seven (347) candidates successfully passed their certification exams resulting in a 94.55% passage rate for the state.






Percentage of Licensed RNs in LA that are of Hispanic Origin






