






PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS ENROLLMENT IN LA (2014-2018)



GRADUATES OF PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS IN LA ACCORDING TO PROGRAM TYPE (2014-2018)




RACIAL DISTRIBUTION OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS IN LA



GENDER OF ENROLLED IN PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS IN LA





The passage rate on the NCLEX-RN for graduates from Louisiana's pre-RN licensure programs continues to exceed that of the nation.



RN TO BSN PROGRESSION IN LOUISIANA'S SCHOOLS OF NURSING




ENROLLMENT IN APRN PROGRAMS IN LA ACCORDING TO ROLE (2014-2018)



In 2018 three hundred and thirty-nine (339) candidates successfully passed their certification exams resulting in a 95.76% passage rate for the state.


GENDER DISTRIBUTION OF LICENSED REGISTERED NURSES RESIDING IN LA






EMPLOYMENT DISTRIBUTION OF LICENSED RNS RESIDING IN LA

TOP 5 POSITIONS HELD BY LICENSED RNS RESIDING IN LA






