




Reasons Why Qualified Applicants are not Admitted to Pre-RN Licensure Programs in LA

- #4 Clinical Placement Sites Not Available


Graduates of Pre-RN Licensure Programs in LA According to Program Type




Age Ranges for Nurse Faculty




Enrollment in Louisiana APRN Programs According to Role


Graduates from APRN Programs in Louisiana According to Role




Highest Degree Held by APRNs Residing in LA 2010-2013
