





GRADUATES OF PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS IN LA ACCORDING TO PROGRAM TYPE (2022-2023)






The passage rate on the NCLEX-RN for graduates from Louisiana's pre-RN licensure programs continues to exceed that of the nation.

RN TO BSN PROGRESSION IN LOUISIANA'S SCHOOLS OF NURSING




GENDER OF GRADUATES FROM APRN PROGRAMS IN LA (2023)

In 2023 three hundred and forty seven (305) candidates successfully passed their certification exams resulting in a 95.31% passage rate for the state.






Percentage of Licensed RNs in LA that are of Hispanic Origin






