Exception to PA Rules

NCSBN Communication P. Griener reported on a NCSBN communication regarding national certification and licensure in subspecialties. Louisiana does not accept certification in subspecialties to meet requirements for APRN licensure. For informational purposes - no action was required.

Request to Accept Notarized Affidavit Confirming Social Security Number in Lieu of the Social Security Cards for E. Tate explained the reason for this request. An email was received from Ed Skornia with O'Grady Peyton International (USA), Inc. requesting the Board consider accepting a notarized affidavit in lieu of the social security card. The Board's attorney has advised staff, it is within the law to accept a notarized affidavit confirming a U.S. social security number in lieu of the actual card.

**Foreign Nurse Graduates**

An email received from Ed Skornia of O'Grady Peyton International (USA), Inc., requested that the Board reconsider the rule that prohibits foreign nurse graduates from receiving temporary permits. E. Tate explained the reasoning behind the current rule.

reconfirmed and that rule changes to permit temporary permits for foreign nurse

graduates not be instituted.

**Retest Policy** 

**45 Day NCLEX-RN** Staff explained that this policy change is in accord with the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NSCBN), which changed its regulations for NCLEX-RN retesting from 90 days to 45 days.
