Dr. Lyon reported that at the request of Dr. Kanter and Secretary Phillips, they were asked to issue 2 emergency rules to allow all RNs and APRNs from any jurisdiction who possess active, unencumbered licenses to continue to practice in LA for 90 days following the end of the Governor's Emergency Declaration, which is planned to expire on March 16, 2022.

**Emergency Rule: LAC 46:XLVII.3327.A.11**

**Motion:** by F. Pinkney, seconded, that the Board approve Emergency Rule: LAC 46:XLVII.3327.A.11 to provide an exception allowing RNs and APRNs to continue to practice nursing in Louisiana with a current, active, unencumbered, unrestricted out-of-state license for a 90-day transition period following the expiration of the Covid-19 public health emergency, such emergency rule to expire June 14, 2022.

There being no nays or abstentions, the motion carried.

**Emergency Rule: LAC 46:XLVII.4513.B.4**


**Motion:** by T. McNabb, seconded, that the Board approve Emergency Rule LAC 46: XLVII.4513.B.4 to provide an exception allowing APRNs practicing without an approved collaborative practice agreement during the Covid-19 public health emergency to continue to practice for a 90-day transition period following the expiration of the public health emergency, such emergency rule to expire June 14, 2022.
