Site Visit Report-Our Lady of the Lake College-Nurse Anesthesia Program:

Ms. Rebouche and Ms. Dean of Willis Knighton Health System requested that an ASN degree and four years experience be accepted as the minimum qualifications for a preceptor for a 5th level BSN student. The ASN staff would be under the direction of the MSN

faculty.

Nursing Shortage:

Dr. Tremblay of the Board of Regents was invited to the meeting and gave an overview of the Continuum for All Louisiana Learners (CALL) initiative. He also discussed how this initiative might impact implementation of articulation plans across the state.

Request from Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center School of Nursing Related to Faculty Qualifications:

Dr. Porche requested the Board consider recognizing individuals who have earned a BSN and a DNP or PhD without a master's degree, as meeting the requirements to serve as faculty in Louisiana.

Discussion ensued at length.

It was suggested that the graduate faculty that volunteered to work on the revision of the graduate annual report form could provide input on this issue.

Chairperson deferred item pending collection of additional information on accreditation, Board rules and national trends.

Request to Conduct Clinical Experiences in Louisiana by University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences College of Nursing:

The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences College of Nursing requests to conduct clinical experiences at Christus Schumpert Health System in Shreveport.

Staff commented on the issue.

Discussion ensued.

Motion:

by Ms. Johnson to approve the request by the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences College of Nursing to conduct clinical experiences at Christus Schumpert Health System in Shreveport. Seconded by Dr. Poirrier

Chairperson proposed an amendment that this approval is good for one (1) year, then the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences College of Nursing must contact the other schools in the area to assure there are no conflicts.

by Ms. Johnson to request that the Nicholls State University provide the name of the Interim or the new Department Head that will be accountable for the ASN Program until its termination due to the retirement of Dr. Cheryl Franklin.

Nurse Refresher Courses:

Nursing Shortage:

Dr. Poirrier discussed the findings from the task force on Improving Matriculation in Nursing Education: General Education through Distance Learning for Nursing.

Dr. Poirrier recommended the Board needs to re-examine if all nursing programs have implemented a mandated articulation plan.

Another recommendation was that the Board asks the nursing programs to submit their issues of what's blocking their articulation program from producing more numbers to Dr. Booth, chair of the sub-committee on Articulation of Nursing Supply and Demand.

Old Business:

Policy on Conditional Approval for Programs in Nursing:

Discussion on two versions of a revision for the *Conditional Approval* for *Programs in Nursing* policy.

Chairperson deferred item for more editing of the 2^{nd} C. option, by the Board lawyers and request them to attend the next committee meeting.

FYI:

Our Lady of the Lake College has partnered with East Jefferson Hospital to admit an additional 50 students in the Accelerated ASN Program, New Orleans campus, in the fall of 2008.

Southeastern Louisiana University School of Nursing will offer the RN to BS curriculum as a fully on-line program beginning fall 2008.

Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center School of Nursing has been organizationally restructured. New appointments include: Dr. Deborah Garbee as Associate Dean of Undergraduate Programs; Dr. Denise Danna as Associate Dean for Professional Practice, Community Service, and Advanced Nursing Practice; Dr. Marsha

Bennett as Associate Dean for Nursing Research, Scholarship and Science; Rose Schaubhut as Assistant Dean for Clinical Nursing Education; Catherine Lopez as Assistant Dean for Student Support Services; and Elizabeth Spivey as Director of the Nursing Skills and Technology Center. Three nursing professorships were also appointed: Dr. Gloria Giarratano as the P.K. Scheerle Professorship in Nursing; Dr. Leslie Pejic as the Sister Henrietta Guyot Professorship in Nursing; and Dr. Yvonne Sterling as the St. Charles General Hospital Auxiliary Professorship in Nursing.

Louisiana College submitted a copy of their "Continuous Improvement Progress Report" required by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education.

Notification received from Louisiana College on the retirement of Dr. Oswald A. Ferry and the appointment of Dr. Elizabeth Battalora as Chair of the Division of Nursing.

ANCC has changed the name of the Public/Community Health CNS certification to Advanced Public Health Nurse certification.

Dr. Ronald Wright was approved as Chancellor of Delgado Community College.

McNeese State University College of Nursing reported reorganization of their BSN curriculum.

Dr. Nora Steele, Board Member, has been appointed as a member of the Innovations in Education Regulation Committee of the National Council of State Boards of Nursing.
