Your request for an opinion of the Board of Nursing regarding the administration, reading, and documentation of the results of intradermal injections and C.M.I. anergy panels by registered nurses, and the delegation of same by the registered to licensed practical nurses and to unlicensed personnel, was presented to the Board on July 22, 1988.

The materials which you sent were circulated to the members of the Board prior to the meeting. After due deliberation, the Board adopted the following opinion:

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In reference to agenda item 3d, it is within the scope of registered nurse practice to administer, read and document the results of intradermal injections and C.M.I. anergy panels, provided said registered nurse has the necessary knowledge and skills and that these are documented in his/her file, and further, that the previously adopted rules of delegation be applied.
